Pop-Up Office



The Farm Service Agency (FSA) provides fire recovery under multiple programs for livestock producers of all sizes:

- Emergency Assistance for Livestock, Honeybees, and Farm-Raised Fish Program (ELAP) provides emergency relief losses for instances such as acres burned to cover supplemental feed costs and hay stored that was burned.
- Livestock Indemnity Program (LIP) offers payments to eligible producers for livestock death losses in excess of normal mortality due to wildfires.
- Emergency Conservation Program (ECP) cost shares with producers to remove debris, repair or replace fencing and/or water conservation structures damaged or destroyed by wildfires (does not cover personal house).
- *The items listed above are not all inclusive, livestock producers should meet with FSA to learn more.*

To make the most of the pop-up office, here is a list of items to bring with you:

- **2021 Disaster Information Form** – complete as much as possible, FSA staff will be on hand to further assist you. (email tk schohr@ucanr.edu for a copy)
- **Leases** – if you lease property bring a copy of the signed lease, or original and we can make a copy for you.
- **Deeds** – if you own the property and are new to working with FSA bring a copy of your deed. (If you don't have a copy of your deed(s) readily available, contact the Plumas County Assessors Office at 530-283-6380 and they can help identify the records you need.)
- **Receipts** – Did you have to buy hay? Bring a copies of the receipt or the originals and we can make a copy on site.
- **Photos** – If you have photos of fire damaged barns, corrals or fences bring your pictures - electronic version can work too!

Burned Trees – UC Cooperative Extension local Forestry Advisor Ryan Tompkins will be on hand to answer questions and provide technical assistance.

Post Fire Land Management – Natural Resources Conservation Service will be on hand to discussion post-fire cost-share land management programs.
